Brothers:

In light of events at the recent National Encampment, it has become clear that we need a larger presence at these Encampments. It has been suggested that we need a minimum of six representatives in order to effect change at the National level. Therefore, I am suggesting that our department begin now to groom representatives for next year's encampment at Lansing, Michigan on August 10-13.

If each camp could send one (or more) representative to the National Encampment, that would be quite sufficient for our purpose of being heard and wielding no small amount of power for the ideas we wish to support. More than one representative per camp would be nothing short of tremendous!
